1. New board members were introduced.
2. No position reports were given.
3. Registration Schedule – Andrew brought in a tentative schedule for the 2007 – 2008 season. Discussions were held on the following:
 - a. Flyers will be taken to Douglas Schools and Dayton Schools to be put in the Peechees. Michelle will make the flyers.
 - b. Registration dates: We will have as many registration dates as possible. We would like to have the kids be able to go and skate after they register once the floor is down.
 - c. Open practice skates will begin on October 23.
 - d. We need to have a coaches meeting to keep them informed about what to do as far as drills and expectations for the coaches. Concerns were brought up about supervision of seniors doing teams as their senior project. It was recommended that an adult, other than the parent, be on the bench to supervise if a player is going to be a coach for the project.
 - e. Parent meeting – better attended if held at the rink.

5. Live demos at the schools: Andrew would like to see live demonstrations at each of the elementary schools by our hockey players. This will hopefully raise interest in the hockey program. Each of the individual PE teachers and their principals need to be approached about this.
6. College Tournament: In order to have a college tournament, we need to have four dressing rooms. It was discussed to either use the stage rooms or put some type of dividers around the rink to allow for dressing space. We need to contact the city to see if we can put up the net for that weekend. We need to investigate getting a hotel or hotels that will give us discounted rates for the tournament. We would need to have some type of coupon that the players and families need to give the hotels to show that they are part of the tournament. We need to some how prove the revenue that this tournament will bring to Carson City. There will be more discussion on this at upcoming meetings.
7. Other business: It was decided that the meetings will be held on Mondays.
