1. Minutes were approved with a motion by Troy and a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Christy. Vote was unanimous to approve.
2. Position Reports: The website has been updated. Minutes will be put on the site 1 week in advance of the upcoming meeting. Everything on the website will be done in pdf.  
An adult and kids referee clinic will be held. Mike will organize this. It is only required that we have Dale come once every two years so we will not have him come this year. Mike will contact Uriah and see if he is interested in doing this. Waving Uriah's fee or giving him compensation for doing the clinic was discussed. Michelle will contact the schools. She will make a ¼ sheet flyer to take to the southern Reno schools.  
Troy downloaded the state sheet. He will give this to Christy to do the stats.  
The pressure washer can't be repaired.  
Tony and Andrew will set up a date for a scorekeeper's clinic. The scorekeepers will need to be over 12 and there will be a set of rules of behavior in the box. It was suggested that we have a binder in the black case with each team name and number, a list of referees/scorekeepers and game schedules. All names must be written legibly on the score sheets. It was also discussed that the scorekeepers must know the rule book because they are officials of the game. This will need to be addressed at the clinic.  
We would like to have a player's clinic at the rink. The clinic would be put on by the 14u with a parent and the 17 u players. There will be stations for stick handling, shooting, stopping, and skating techniques. A goalie clinic will be held if we can find someone to run it. Christy will talk to Rich Geiser and Tony will talk to Mattie about doing this. There will be a scrimmage. Times discussed were 12u from 9:00 – 1:00 and 14u and 17 u from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The date discussed was November 17. Cost would be \$25 which includes a t shirt and lunch. We will continue to plan this.
3. Schedule Review – The new dates for the schedule for the 2007 – 2008 year were discussed. The new schedule will be put up for a vote at the August 13 meeting. Some other discussions about the schedule were: an Ironman Tournament, an open skate without hockey, and dodgeball. We would like to see a Lacrosse season during the mini season from March through May. We need to see about the High School League. Andrew will contact Norm. Our schedules on Saturday will be dependant

on whether there is a high school league or not. More discussion on who will run this will be at future meetings.

5. College Tournament: More information is coming. Ward will investigate using tents as locker rooms. Hotels in Carson will be contacted to see if there is a discount that can be given for the players and families. Pizza places in town will be contacted to see if they will sell pizza at the rink during the tournament as a fundraisers for the league. Also, it is suggested that we sell Costco muffins or have City Café Bakery come in to sell breakfast goodies. Theses will be investigated. We need to know what is supplied by the tournament such as refs, scorekeepers, pucks. Andrew will contact them about this. Also, Andrew will contact the city about putting up nets for this tournament for safety.

6. Other Business: Facilities Manager- we would like to have a committee head to oversee the cleaning and maintenance of the rink. It was suggested that we have a committee head and 3 or 4 people to do the maintenance and cleaning. More discussion will be held. Christy will contact Justin Ortera’s father to see if he is interested in cleaning the rink.

Michelle will make a flyer for a swap for equipment. She will call it Leave it if you got it, take it if you want it. People will be encouraged to donate their outgrown equipment so that others can use it.

We would like to see if the city would provide storage for us in a shed outside the garage. This will be explored.

There is a big metal building in Washoe Valley for sale. Troy will see what the cost is and if the building is big enough to house the league.

The August 13 meeting will be used for a vote for the new schedule.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 with Ward making the motion and Mike with the 2<sup>nd</sup>.  
Vote to adjourn was unanimous.
