Minutes from Feb have been approved passed unanimously. Jan meeting minutes were approved via email Christy motioned, John seconded all others approved.

John said he is still learning about the scorekeeper's job. He has done a great job organizing the paperwork so that it is easily accessible. He has scorekeepers signed up for the weekend.

Teri would like permission to order plaques for the sponsors. We will have a 5x7 with a photo of the kids. Approx cost should be under \$100.00

Troy- games with Bishop last weekend for the younger age group went well. They would like to come up again March 28 or 29th and also have Fallon bring up some younger kids as well. Adult league will end first weekend in May, the rink closure date is approx May 16th.

The mini season - we have sheets posted up so they can sign up for 10 & 12, and 14 & 17's. The cost will be \$25.00 same as last season. Dan first the motion, Ken 2nd all in favor none abstained-passes. There will be 2 games each night on Wed and Thurs starting 3/25 & 3/26.

Ken said stats are going ok and he is pretty current with them thru 2/22. He will try to get the information on the website.

Brenda wanted to thank all of the parents for snack bar assistance. She has had great success in getting volunteers and this has allowed us (along with Teri shopping and stocking) to keep the snack bar open and available to coaches, players and parents.

Andrew will talk to Joe at Play it Again for prizes for the skills and drills 2nd weekend in March. This is open to all kids.
